# MTSE - 2020

Just like every year, NAVPRAYAS is conducting MTSE 2020 for students of class 5 to class 10 this year too. Due to COVID-19 pandemic, MTSE will be held completely ONLINE and FREE OF COST

There will be 2 stage of MTSE 2020 as following:-

1. Online Test
2. Online Interview

Syllabus: 70% from Previous grades and 30% from current grades.

Applicant's school/coaching ID or Fee receipt

❖ Please read the following instructions carefully:

**As soon as you log in, an alert box will pop up asking for access to your camera. Please click on 'Allow' to give access to it. Please use Google Chrome browser only to appear for the exam.**

1. The test duration is 2 hours.
2. Please ensure you have good internet connectivity for the entire duration of the test.
3. You can appear for the test on a mobile phone/laptop. Make sure you have a proper working webcam(in case of laptop/desktop) or front camera(in case of a mobile phone) because you will be under surveillance during the test.

## Some Do's and Don'ts

1. Keep all your text materials like the book, notes, electronic gadgets and programmable calculators, etc., away
2. Have suitable 4G / 3G internet connectivity with sufficient data. Also, a standby would be advisable.
3. The device which you are going to use for examinations must have a front end camera so that your face is visible while you are taking the examination.
4. The camera and microphone must be kept ON throughout the examination.
5. You cannot move out of the browser during the examinations and trying to move away from the camera or parallelly opening the browser in another device or tab shall lead to the closure of the examinations.
6. You will also be notified about your activity if you are moving outside the window or some noise is heard around you or somebody is moving around you or if you are referring to any book or if you are turning your head etc. Avoid going out for restrooms during the examinations.
7. It is not possible to re-login and correct your answers.
8. Do not indulge in any kind of malpractice. Your test examinations are proctored and the faculty members will monitor you at the back end, like watching the examinations in a classroom.

All candidates must ensure they have the right login credentials.

**WARNING** -You will be responsible for any kind of misbehaviour and that may lead to disqualification.

### **Question Paper Format:**

The Question paper has 80 questions clustered in two Sections:

**Section 1:** MAT (Mental Ability Test) which contains 35 questions. Each question has four choices a, b, c and d out of which only one is correct.

**Section 2:** SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) which contains 45 questions. Each question has four choices a, b, c and d out of which only one is correct.

### **MARKING SCHEME:**

There is no marking scheme for the Mock Test. For the main Exam Marking Scheme are as follow:-

Q.1 to Q. 35: (+2) for Correct Answer, (0) for any other cases.

Q.36 to Q.80: (+2) for Correct Answer, (0) for No Response & (-1) for any other cases.
