CHESS

~The Ultimate Thinking Game!

Chess isn't a game of luck. Chess requires a lot of focus and concentration – to the point where you may end up so focused on the game that the rest of the world around you temporarily fades away. For many players, chess is a way to forget about the stresses of the world, and focus on the game at hand.

Registration Fee : ₹ 20/-
Mode : Offline
Participation : Individual

Eligibility:

- Category G1: Below 14 Years.
- Category G2: From 14 Years to 18 Years.
- Category G3: Above 18 Years.

Note: All matches will be knockout matches.

Instructions

- 1) Each player must make all his moves in the time specified for the game. Total game time should not exceed 10 minutes per player per game.
- 2) Before play begins, both players should inspect the position of the pieces and the setting of the clock after the toss, since once each side has completed a move, the position on the board and the time on the clock remains as set.
- 3) Each player must press the clock with the same hand that moves the pieces.
 - When castling a player may use both hands.
 - When capturing or completing a promotion both hands may be used if it is clear that the clock is pressed after the move is determined.
- 4) The player who wins the toss will be given the option to choose between white and black pieces. The one who chooses white pieces will make the first move and the player who gets the black pieces will get the chance to adjust the position of the timer.
- 5) Except for pressing the clock, neither player should touch the clock except:
 - To straighten it.
 - Each player must press the clock after their move is made.
 - A player should not keep a hand on or over the clock.

6) **Defining a WIN**

A game is won by the player:

- Who has checkmated his opponent's king.
 - Whose opponent resigns.
 - If the opponent takes an illegal move for the second time. (First illegal move can be reverted with a warning)
 - If one of the kings is stalemated. The player with more time remaining on the chess clock wins.
 - If the opponent runs out of time.
- 7) If a player accidentally displaces one or more pieces, they shall be replaced in the player's own time. If it is necessary, the opponent may press the clock without making a move. If the player presses the clock after displacing pieces, then it will account for an illegal move.
 - 8) In case of a dispute invigilator may stop and pick up the clock while the tournament director is being summoned.
 - 9) In any unclear situation the tournament director will consider the testimony of both players and any reliable witnesses before rendering a decision.
 - 10) Spectators and players in another game are not to speak or otherwise interfere. If a spectator interferes in any way that may affect the result of the game, the tournament director may cancel the game and rule that a new game be played instead and expel the offending party from the playing room. If the offending party is participating in the event, the tournament director may be assessed up to expulsion from the event.
 - 11) A player who has played an illegal move must retract it and make a legal move with the piece touched prior to pressing the clock. If no legal move exists with that piece then he may make any legal move.
 - 12) A legal move is completed when the hand leaves the piece and the clock is pressed.
 - 13) Moving the King next to another King is an illegal move.
 - 14) Castling Rules:- There are a number of cases when castling is not permitted.
 - Your king has been moved earlier in the game.
 - The rook that castles has been moved earlier in the game.
 - There are pieces standing between your king and rook.
 - The king is in check.
 - The king would be in check after castling.
 - 15) The decision of the tournament director will be final.
 - 16) The move made by the opponent whether legal or illegal must be verified by you only. NAVPRAYAS will not be responsible for any kind of illegal move.
